### **Meter Reads**

Town of Alpine employees are currently out reading water meters for the yearly assessments. It is this time of year we inspect meter pits and read the meters. This is a several week process to get all the meter readings completed and you may see employees repairing meter pits later in the summer due to some possible issues that could be discovered during the yearly inspection.

As Alpine continues to grow our current meter reading process is time consuming and outdated. The Town of Alpine was approved for a grant in February 2023 to add radio read devices to our existing water meters so the meters can be read directly through set "gateway" devices mounted on towers or taller structures. The two systems being considered are hybrid Automatic Meter Reading (AMR) system and Advanced Metering Infrastructure (AMI) system. This new metering process will change the yearly meter readings to monthly meter readings making the process more efficient and allow for timely leak detection. The expected completion date for the radio read upgrade is summer 2024.

### **Alpine's Level 1 Water Master Plan Study**

In May the Town of Alpine was selected to receive a grant that allows for a water master plan study. This study will help identify problem areas in the water system, develop a plan for future growth, and provide a GIS mapping of the water system. This study takes 2 years to complete and will ensure that the water system grows effectively with the anticipated growth of the town.

# Alpine Planning & Zoning

## Permits are Required



**ATTENTION HOMEOWNERS** -- **NO** construction, alteration or expansion of any site, building or structure shall be initiated or completed by any private landowner, contractor, or a public agency before receiving an **approved** building permit from the Town of Alpine. This includes: Any new buildings; Additions to all existing structures, Remodel with structural changes to or in an existing structure, Utility line installation and/or replacement, any mechanical improvements, Demolition of an existing building/shed, Change in type of "Occupancy" of a building, Accessory Buildings with or without permanent foundations.

**Building Permits also include: Storage sheds, green houses, roofing applications, construction of decks, construction of fences, plumbing improvement, electrical improvements on commercial facilities, propane tank installations, utility improvements or changes and replacement of door and/or windows.**

As per Section 2.5, Sub Section 2-501 (h): If a person commences building development or remodeling for which a permit is required with having first obtained a permit, they are in violation of the Land Use and Development Code (LUDC). Such person shall pay **twice the fee** for said permit, costs associated with the Town's investigation of the violation, any hearings to abate, and included reasonable attorney, engineer, inspector and surveyor's fees. The payment of such fees shall not relieve the person from fully complying with the requirements of the LUDC, nor does it automatically secure the permit or preclude a violation for the given infraction. The provisions of this article do not apply to emergency work, only if there is a or would have been an unreasonable delay in obtaining the permit.



