Alpine Mountain Days was started in 1990 by Jan Rollins and Marge Grover, the founders and co-chairs of this weekend festival. From the very first "Mountain Days" these two ladies had a vision which has become reality. With the help of volunteers, the generosity of many businesses and individuals, and the participation of craftsmen, vendors, and those who attend, this event has grown year by year into one of the largest weekend festivals in the area.

WATER & SEWER RATES SCHEDULED FOR A RATE INCREASE IN JULY 2018



For Town of Alpine Residents you will see an increase on your utility bills this summer. 245 Ordinance No. 2016-08 states that for Fiscal Year 2019 (July 1, 2018) the base rate will increase to \$22.00 a month from \$20.00 a month. Sewer ERUs are also scheduled for an increase for Fiscal Year 2019 (July 1, 2018) the amount of the increase was TBD in ordinance and has now been determined by the Town Council to increase to \$45.00 a month from \$42.00 a month. The scheduled increases are set to keep up with the costs it takes to maintain these systems.

**BUSINESS LICENSES** are required within the incorporated boundaries of the Town of Alpine. Business Licenses are valid from July 1st —June 30th of each fiscal year. Business Licenses are up for renewal on June 30th 2018. Renewal notices have been sent out for previous license holders.

**CREDIT CARDS** are accepted for Water/Sewer only... all other payments must be made with cash, check, or money order.

**BUILDING PERMITS** Permits are required within the incorporated boundaries of the Town of Alpine. If you are unsure if your project requires a permit please call our office for clarification.

**ANIMAL LICENSES** are required in the Town of Alpine. We have received several complaints about dogs roaming the town without owners present for voice command or physical restraint control. Please do not allow your dogs to roam freely through town and be sure to get your pets licensed if you live within the incorporated boundaries of the Town of Alpine.



## ANNEXATION OF ALPINE MEADOWS

The Town of Alpine is currently in the process of working with the Alpine Meadows Homeowners Association on the annexation of that area into the Town of Alpine. The Town has currently had 2 readings of 252 Ordinance No. 2018-02 and a 3rd is scheduled for June 19th. Alpine Meadows has 188 platted lots that the Town provides water and sewer services to. Once the annexation process is completed all building permits will go through the Town of Alpine Planning and Zoning, animal licenses will be required, and usage rates/readiness to serve fees will change to the current rates set forth by 245 Ordinance No. 2016-08.
