PLANNING & ZONING MEETINGS Take place the 2nd and 4th Tuesday of each month. until switching to the winter schedule in November though March to one meeting per month on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Tuesday of each month beginning @ 7 p.m. ~ Town Council Chambers 250 River Circle, Alpine, WY.

ALPINE MUNICIPAL COURT Takes place the 2nd Wednesday of each month @ 10:30 a.m. ~ Town Council Chambers 250 River Circle, Alpine, WY.

BUSINESS LICENSES are required for anyone conducting business within the Town of Alpine.

**BUILDING PERMITS** are required within the incorporated boundaries of the Town of Alpine. If you are unsure please call our office to find out.

ANIMAL LICENSES are required in the Town of Alpine. We have received several complaints about dogs roaming the town without owners present for voice command or physical restraint control. Please do not allow your dogs to roam freely through town.

CREDIT CARDS are accepted for Water/Sewer only... all other payments must be made with cash or check.

OFFICE CLOSURES Town of Alpine offices will be closed on October 9, 2017 for Columbus day & November 23rd & 24th for Thanksgiving Holiday.

NO DIG Town of Alpine prohibits new water connections involving excavations within the Town owned right a way or prescribed Town utility easement between the dates of November 15 and April 15 unless for emergency purposes or otherwise pre-approved by the Town.


